Icknield 12 – 5.9.04

The results are as previously reported but it can be added that Tony Perkins was 2nd on handicap (289.02) and Scott Edwards 3rd with (285.70). The Nomads were the second team with 607.04 behind the Icknield (no change there) who racked up 683.55.

Norlond 25 Mile TT 19.09.04

Two Nomads were in action on the 'new' version of the 25, which, after being out of action most of the season due to repairs on the Tempsford Bridge, was available again. The weather, the wind especially, wasn't kind to the riders who had to battle against a headwind from the south. Steve Hunt of the Icknield won the event in 55.24, David Ledgerton completed the course in 1:03:53 and Rob Bryan coming home with 1:10:23 to win first place in the handicap competition with a time of 45:11.

Stevenage CC 2 Up TTT 12 Miles 2.10.04

Nick Senechal and David Ledgerton were the lone Nomads in this event held over a 12 mile course based around Guilden Morden. While waiting to go off last, the wind rose from strong

to extremely gusty and strong requiring the riders to lean their bikes at strange angles to remain upright! Messrs. C Nichols and N Coventry from High Wycombe won the event in 26:35, the Nomad pairing completed in 31.07 in thirteenth place.
